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Search for Hadronic Shore in High-Energy Nuclear Collisions

In this talk, I will start with the discussion on the evidences for the formation of hot/dense matter in high-energy nuclear collisions at RHIC ($\sqrt{s} = 200$ GeV). In such high-energy collisions, the partonic degrees of freedom dominate the early dynamic evolution [1]. In order to demonstrate the transition from hadronic matter to partonic matter and identify the possible 'phase boundary' on the QCD phase diagram, the energy scan in the region $\sqrt{s} = 200 - 2$ GeV is necessary. The RHIC energy-scan program and the GSI-FAIR high-density program [2] then will be discussed. Finally, the requirements for detector system will be briefly addressed.
