

AUTHOR CHECK SHEET

PAPERS SHOULD BE IN THE FOLLOWING FORMAT:

- 1) **Typed double-spaced throughout, single-column text one side of paper.**
- 2) **No reference numbers in the Abstract.**
- 3) **Acronyms spelled out when first used.**
- 4) **Complete byline including authors names, institution(s) and complete address(es).**
- 5) **Figures and tables collected at the end (i.e., not included in the body of the text).**
- 6) **All figure captions are collected in a single list. Captions make the figure intelligible on sight (e.g., labeled parts are named).**
- 7) **Tables must have captions and be numbered.**
- 8) **Each figure, table, and reference is mentioned in the text and cited in order of appearance.**
- 9) **References are in normal journal style (no titles for journal articles and list location of publisher).**
- 10) **No footnotes at bottom of page.**
- 11) **Figures do not include thin lines, small symbols or alphanumerics, because they will disappear or become illegible.**
- 12) **We can print color figures (see enclosed AIP Rate Sheet for the cost of printing color figures).**
- 13) **Label each figure with its number, paper number, name of first author.**
- 14) **Check the length of the final version (see “Estimates of Finished Length”).**
- 15) **Please make sure that your text is page numbered.**
